Vendor Rules and Regulations

April 12, 2012

12:00 – 4:00 pm

1. **Installation and Set-up of Exhibits:** Delivery, installation and set-up time will be from 8-11:45 am on April 12, 2011 Sponsors will get preferred placement and then the remaining spaces will be first come first serve. NO CARS will be allowed in the vendor area.
1. **Dismantling and Removal of Exhibits:** Exhibitors may not begin to dismantle, pack or remove any exhibition materials until 4 pm. All exhibits must be removed from the premises the day of the event.
2. **Exhibit Restrictions:** Exhibits must conform to the size of the space allocated to the exhibitor and must not obstruct the view or interfere with other exhibits. All demonstrations, discussions or other activities must be confined to your table area unless prior arrangements have been discussed with ABC.
3. **Protection of Industrial Properties Property:** No damage shall be done to the site. Exhibitors violating this regulation are expressly bound, at their expense, to repair any such damage, which they, their agents or employees may cause.
4. **Liability:** The exhibitor agrees to assume all liability for and all liability for and to indemnify Associated Builders and Contractors (ABC) Central Texas Chapter (CTC) and Industrial Properties from and against any and all claims, actions, damage arising from or out of the installation, set-up, operation, dismantling and/or removal of the exhibit, if caused in whole or in part by the act or omission of the exhibitor, its agents, contractors or employees. The exhibitor hereby releases Associated Builders and Contractors Central Texas Chapter and Industrial Properties of any liability whatsoever, and is required to name ABC CTC as an additional insured on its General Liability Coverage.

Chili Cook Off Rules
April 12, 2012

Rules:

1. Electricity will be provided. Bring extension cords.
2. Cook off areas for loading and unloading only. NO CARS will be allowed in the cook off area.
3. Cups, spoons, napkins will be provide for taste testing. Teams are responsible for any garnishes, ie: cheese, fritos, crackers, onions, bread, etc.
4. Please attempt to prepare enough food for 15-20 people, plus the judges.
5. Food may be prepared off site.
6. Chili team can start setting up at 9 am. Sponsors will get preferred placement and then the remaining spaces will be first come first serve.
7. Chili must be fit for human consumption! Judges Criteria: aroma, color, consistency, taste and aftertaste. Judging is based on each category about with a scale of 1-10. The highest collective score will be the winner.
8. Judging begins @ 2:30 pm.
9. Teams will be required to submit (2) cups of chili to the judges. Containers will be provided; turn in the containers to predesignated area at the judging station.
